Once your character is ready, you can easily save the image. For mobile users, a long press followed by tapping the download icon does the trick.

To further enhance your character, revisit the chat group. A prompt like /imagine, followed by the character's URL and a scenario, say, 'in a schoolroom', can yield delightful scenes. Play around with emotions, backdrops, and objects to enrich your visuals.
